"Killer Clown" Confesses to Murder



Not To Only 1, But 33 Young Boys And Men

Mr. John Wayne Gacy, a.k.a. Killer Clown, has confessed to killing and committing over 33 counts of sexual assault in 1968, most bodies found buried under his home. Found guilty in 1980, he was given multiple death penalties and life sentences, and later executed by lethal injection May 10, 1994.

Leading Up To The Crime

Gacy was accused of rape multiple times and imprisoned for 15 years, and after being let out of prison, was accused 17 more times, after that would then be questioned for the disappearance of others. His first known killing took place in 1972, Gacy, the 1st of Timothy McCreary after being the back into his home.

Gacy's murders were all perpetrated by Gacy under the name, providing construction work. He would dig up, usually known, and kill them, usually through strangulation, and in many cases, Gacy stated they were covered by an alternate personality, as mental health professionals testified for both sides about Gacy's mental state.

Doing The Time

One of the Most Vicious Serial Killers in U.S. History

Having been irretrievably rejected in an elderly plea, he had been placed in Chicago, while on trial, Gacy stated that he was guilty of "kissing a candy without a lollipop," being found guilty of committing 33 murders, he was sentenced to serve 12 death sentences, and 23 life sentences, being imprisoned at the Joliet Correctional Center for over a decade, he confessed and later described being a part of the outrage.

Time Of Death

You're Done, Son.

John Wayne Gacy died by lethal injection on May 10, 1994, at the Stateville Correctional Center in Joliet, Illinois. His final special meal was a dinner from KFC, a pound of fresh strawberries and french fries. With a rally of people outside cheering on his death, it was the end of Gacy's 52 year long life, and the end of his heinous crimes.

Leading Up To The Crime

Gacy was accused of rape multiple times, once imprisoned for 10 years, and after being let out on parole, was accused 3 more times after and would then be questioned for the disappearances of others. His first known killing took place in 1972, taking the life of Timothy McCoy after luring the teen into his home.

Gacy's murders were all premeditated. As Gacy would lure in his victims, promising construction work, he would capture, sexually assault, and kill them mostly through strangulation with a rope. In questions of sanity, Gacy claimed they were committed by an alternate personality as mental health professionals testified for both sides about Gacy's mental state.

Committing the Crime

Mapping The Incident

A student by the name of Robert Priest, 15 years old, was reported missing from a pharmacy which he worked after school. Telling fellow coworkers that he went to talk to a contractor, and Gacy had previously been in there earlier talking about such work. After Gacy denied ever talking to Priest, the Des Plaines police checked Gacy's record, discovering that he had done time for sodomy. Evidence had been found in the Gacy residence after police filed for a search warrant on the home, finding a 1975 high school class ring, drivers' licenses from other people, handcuffs, a 2x4 with holes drilled in the ends, a syringe, clothing too small for Gacy, and a photo receipt from the pharmacy Priest worked at.

Shortly after, one of Gacy's workers had told the police that Gacy confessed to more than 30 murders. Not too long after, Gacy had been arrested for marijuana possession, and after police pulled a second warrant on his home, then they had discovered human bones in the crawlspace beneath the house. When being informed he would be charged for murder, he confessed to police to some 25-30 murders. Gacy stated that many of his murders involved picking up male teenage runaways or prostitutes off the streets, take them back to his house promising either money or sex, or even grab them by force, and after sexually abusing them then strangle them to death.

Being imprisoned at the Menard Correctional Center for over a decade, he confessed and later denied being guilty of the charges.
