

Poetic Periodic Table “Square”

- Select a 12” x 9” construction paper of the appropriate color. Black for solids, green for liquids and blue for gases.
- Use a vertical orientation.
- Form a 1” border: yellow for metals, orange for metalloids and red for nonmetals.
- Be creative... include samples, pictures and/or drawings of the element in its pure form, or something in which the element is used.
- Write a cinquain, which is a structured poem composed of 5 lines and eleven words. It’s format is shown below:

Line 1 name of element and its symbol
 Line 2 two words identifying the chemical family or element’s appearance
 Line 3 three words describing a major characteristic of that element
 Line 4 four words describing where the element is found and/or how it is used
 Line 5 derivative of the element’s name, or derivative of its chemical symbol

A word can only be used **once**. For example, if you use “gas”, you cannot use “gas” again, nor the derivative words “gaseous” or “gases”.

Examples:

Fermium – Fm	Tungsten - W
Actinoid series	white, hard
Short life span	highest melting point
Produced by uranium fission	light bulb filaments; abrasives
Enrico Fermi	Wolfram (German)
