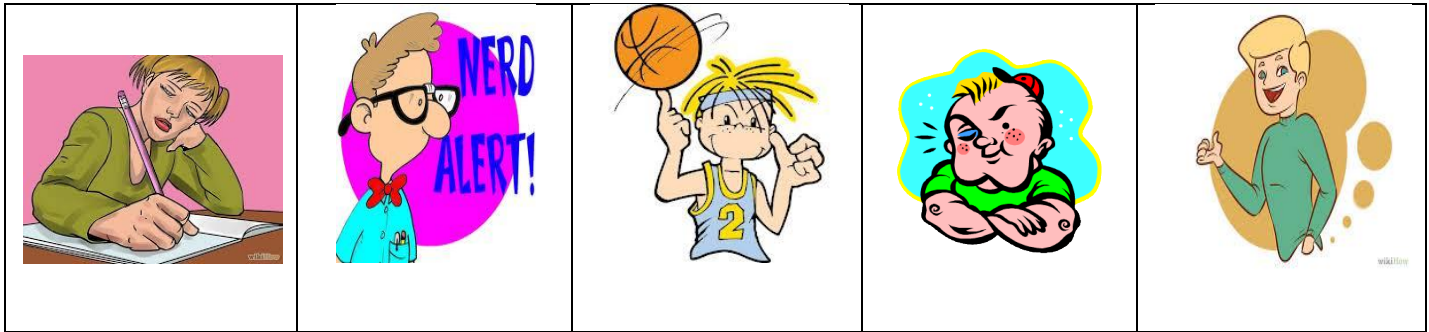

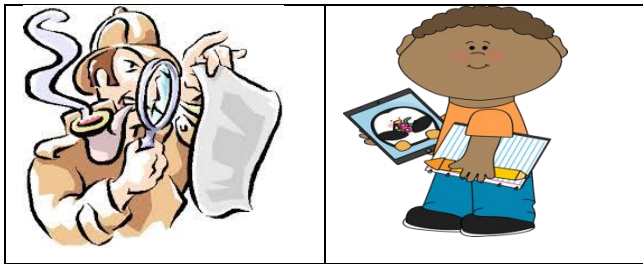
The Kilroy Caper

Five students met on the same day each week for study help. They studied in Mrs. Ancheta's room.

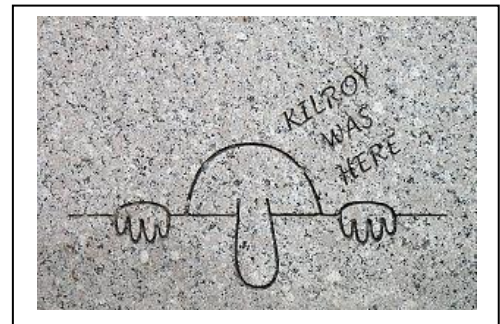
